

Presentation of FY 2018-2019 Budget
May 31, 2018
9:00 a.m.

The Town of Pink Hill held a Presentation of the FY 2018-2019 Budget on Thursday, May 31, 2018 at 9:00 a.m. in the town hall board room. Present for the meeting were Mayor Carol Sykes, Commissioners Mike Hill, James Quinn, Public Works Director Timmy Kennedy and Town Clerk/Finance Officer Kimberly Mitchell. Commissioner Murphy was unable to be present due to unforeseen circumstances

No visitors were present for the budget presentation.

Town Clerk/Finance Officer Kimberly Mitchell presented the 2018-2019 Water Fund, General Fund and the Economic Development Fund budgets to the board.

The General Fund budget includes the purchase of a new lap top for one of the police cars and Police Pak Support for desk top computers in Police Department and an all in one copier/printer/scanner for the town hall office. The budget also includes a 50/50 state grant and 4 other grants for the PHVFD. The PHVFD will receive a skid unit and other equipment and gear.

The Water Fund budget includes well rehab, an air scrubber for lift station #1. It also includes a \$1.00 increase in the flat rate user fee for sewer and a sewer increase of \$0.50 per 1,000 gallon for In and Out of town customers including DRSD customers, Lenoir County schools and Duplin County sewer customers.

Commissioner Hill made a motion to accept the presentation of the General Fund, Water Fund and Economic Development 2018-2019 Budgets by Finance Officer Kimberly Mitchell. Commissioner Quinn seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Town Clerk/Finance Officer Kimberly Mitchell reminded the town board of the public hearing and regular board meeting being held on Tuesday, June 19, 2018 beginning at 6:45 p.m.

With there being no further business to be discussed the meeting was concluded.
